LT. GOVERNOR MOLLY GRAY TO RELEASE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FROM STATEWIDE RECOVER STRONGER TOUR

What: Lt. Governor Molly Gray will share findings and recommendations from her statewide Recover Stronger listening tour. Over the past several months, Lt. Governor Gray spent a day in a different county in Vermont each week to hear directly from Vermonters on how the pandemic has impacted their businesses, families, and communities and the additional resources needed to not only recover, but recover stronger from the COVID-19 pandemic.

In particular, Lt. Governor Gray sought the feedback of Vermonters directly on how the State should invest the \$2.7 billion coming to Vermont through the American Rescue Plan Act.

The Lt. Governor will be joined by five individuals she heard from during the tour to share their personal experiences as well as possible solutions for some of the most challenging issues facing Vermonters.
