Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to direct the
Agency of Education to provide postsecondary career technical education
courses at regional technical centers for Firefighter I and Emergency Medical
Responder certifications through the Dual Enrollment Program.

An act relating to providing emergency service courses at regional technical
centers

1 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

2 Sec. 1. EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDERS; PROGRAMS OF STUDY

3 The Agency of Education shall coordinate with the following partners to
4 provide at each of the regional technical centers one or more postsecondary
5 career technical education programs that lead to Firefighter I and Emergency
6 Medical Responder certifications through the Dual Enrollment Program
7 created in 16 V.S.A. § 944:

8 (1) the Division of Fire Safety within the Department of Public Safety;

9 (2) the Emergency Preparedness, Response and Injury Prevention

10 Division within the Department of Health;

11 (3) the Student Pathways Division within the Agency of Education; and

12 (4) the respective supervisory authorities for each regional technical

13 center.

14 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

15 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
