# THE HEALTH CARE COMPACT

WHAT

- ✔ The Health Care Compact is an interstate compact.
  - ✔ Agreement between two or more states.
  - ✔ With Congressional consent, has full force of federal law.
  - ✔ More than 200 compacts are currently in operation.
  - ✔ Established in Article I, Section 10 of the Constitution.
- ✔ Examples of existing interstate compacts.
  - ✔ Port Authority of New York and New Jersey.
  - ✔ Driver's License Compact.
  - ✔ Interstate Insurance Compact.

*"Who decides?"*


# THE HEALTH CARE COMPACT
