


ROAD MILE ANALYSIS







- \$920,712.00 issued to 2,935 applicants in 2020.
- \$355,421.89 issued to 2,297 applicants in calendar year 2021.
 - Program restarted in May 2021.
 - 2021 awards included retroactive reimbursement from Jan. 2021 – Dec. 2021.
 - Over 10,000 monthly awards were made in 2021.
