Pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 129(f):

A board may appoint a hearing officer, who shall be an attorney admitted to practice in this State, to conduct a hearing which would otherwise be heard by the board. A hearing officer appointed under this subsection may administer oaths and exercise the powers of the board properly incidental to the conduct of the hearing. When a hearing is conducted by a hearing officer, the officer shall report findings of fact and conclusions of law to the board. The report shall be made within 60 days of the conclusion of the hearing unless the board grants an extension. The board may take additional evidence and may accept, reject, or modify the findings and conclusions of the hearing officer. Judgment on the findings shall be rendered by the board.

The Vermont Board of Professional Engineering hereby delegates to the OPR case manager standing authority to appoint a hearing officer to conduct disciplinary hearings in cases where: (1) in the judgment of the case manager, the case does not pertain to a question of professional judgment, or (2) a respondent is alleged to have defaulted.
