I WAS VERY GLAD TO HAVE A CANDID DISCUSSION WITH SERGEANT MESLIN ABOUT THE PROPER PROCEDURE TO FOLLOW IN ORDER TO HAVE THE STATE POLICE DO AN INVESTIGATION (AND HOPEFULLY PROSECUTE AGAINST CRIMINAL ACTIONS) FOR INCARCERATED VERMONT CITIZENS. The State of Vermont would no longer have to pay 2000 people to believe that dishonesty is the norm for state employees. When I say the State of Vermont, I mean each and every citizen who pays those salaries, and believe they have invested in an honest system. Your idea for a performance-based compensation is so needed for caseworkers and all community-based employees. (probation, parole, furlough)

Currently, my "points" are too high to be in regular population, but nobody knows how the point system works, except that if I learn the difference between a checking account + a savings account in my points go down. -- You have got to be kidding?!? This is what the tax dollars are going towards. I'm being punished because I speak out against things that harm others. I have been blessed with patience + compassion for others, and I'll keep sticking up for the most vulnerable. TAKE CARE + THANK YOU! (Use back if necessary)
