**1. Call to Order:**

The report includes the information that due to potential fraud the Office has stopped accepting applications from graduates of nursing programs in Haiti. Additionally, M. Botter reported that with the continued volume of international applicants and in preparation for e-

licensing “go-live”, the Office has hired a temporary employee to assist with international applications through the first week of December.

Recommendations from the APRN Advisory Committee were shared with the Board. After discussion a consensus was reached by the Board to eliminate any formal collaborative agreement or mentorship for new graduates from the APRN draft rules.
  
- G. Christian Science Nurses** – Larissa Snorek-Yates spoke to the Board on H.379 regarding Christian Science Nursing. She indicated that a “statement of non-objection” was being sought. The Board will discuss the request at the November meeting after reviewing documents that Ms. Yates provided to the Board.

5. **Public Comment:** Paul Harrington, Executive Director of the Vermont Medical Society, presented the opinion of the Medical Society regarding the section of the proposed revision to the Administrative Rules relevant to APRN transition to practice. Mr. Harrington indicated that the greatest concern was that new APRN graduates would be able to start their own independent practice without a formal relationship with a MD or APRN. The position of the Medical Society is that no new graduate (MD or APRN) is ready to start treating patients independently and need a formal mentorship or collaborating relationship. Mr. Harrington noted that physicians are required to have 1-3 years of post-graduate supervision.
