Sec. 10. MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT RATES; PRIMARY CARE AT 100

PERCENT OF MEDICARE FISCAL YEAR 2024

It is the intent of the General Assembly that Vermont's health care system should reimburse all Medicaid participating providers at rates that are equal to 100 percent of the Medicare rates for the services, with first priority for primary care providers. In support of this goal, in its fiscal year 2024 budget proposal, the Department of Vermont Health Access shall either provide reimbursement rates for Medicaid participating providers for primary care services at rates that are equal to 100 percent of the Medicare rates for the services or, in accordance with 32 V.S.A. § 307(d)(6), provide information on the additional amounts that would be necessary to achieve full reimbursement parity with the Medicare rates.
