<p>What is the Paris Pledge for Action? The Paris Pledge for Action is a unique opportunity for non-state actors to have their climate leadership recognized in the context of COP21, and to show their support for the ambition of the agreement that should be reached in Paris. Organizations pledge their support to implement the results of the agreement immediately, but also to achieve and exceed the ambition of the agreement that results from COP21.</p>	<p>Qu'est-ce que l'Appel de Paris ? It is being shared directly with organizations, businesses, regions, cities and investors, and not publically, under the embargo. Who is leading the Paris Pledge for Action initiative?

The French COP21 Presidency has initiated the call for the Paris Pledge for Action and is inviting all organizations, businesses, regions, cities and investors to join the Paris Pledge for Action.

When will the Paris Pledge for Action be launched?

The Paris Pledge for Action is open for joining now. It will be officially launched shortly after COP21, if an agreement is reached. Details will be confirmed nearer the time.

How can my organization join the Paris Pledge for Action?

The Pledge is open for sign up now. You can register your organization via the online form: www.parispledgeforaction.org. Organizations joining the pledge before December 9th will be guaranteed to be listed as a signatory on the Paris Pledge for Action website at the time of launch.

Organizations who sign up after that may not be listed until after the launch, although we will seek to include all signatories that come in before the official close of COP. The Paris Pledge for Action will remain open for further signatories after COP21.

What if my organization hasn't made a commitment to an existing initiative?

The Paris Pledge for Action brings together non-state who are making commitments to act on climate change. There are many opportunities to

Qui est à l'origine de cette initiative?

If you haven't signed up to a specific initiative or commitment(s), this doesn't preclude you from joining the Paris Pledge for Action. You are still eligible to do so if you are doing your bit to take action in your field of expertise; if you are willing to support the implementation of the objectives of COP21; and put your effort into meeting and exceeding the ambition. Furthermore, having already signed a pledge or similar initiative via another coalition doesn't preclude you from also signing the Paris Pledge for Action.

What if I join the Paris Pledge for Action and want to remove my organization at a later date?

If at any point you wish to have your organization's name removed from the Paris Pledge for Action, please email info@parispledgeforaction.org. It would be helpful for us to know why you wish to be removed; however it is not mandatory and you do not need to state a reason why.

Who is managing the Paris Pledge for Action and my data?

The University of Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership (based in Cambridge, UK) is managing the website and signatory data for the Paris Pledge for Action on behalf of the French COP21 Presidency.

As cities, regions, businesses, investors, civil society groups, trade unions and other signatories, coming from every sector of society and every corner of the world, we realize that dangerous climate change threatens our ability and the ability of future generations to live and thrive in a peaceful and prosperous world. We also realize that taking strong action to reduce emissions can not only reduce the risks of climate change but also deliver better growth and sustainable development.

As a result, we the undersigned, affirm our strong commitment to a safe and stable climate in which temperature rise is limited to under 2 degrees Celsius.

In support of this, we welcome the adoption of a new, universal climate agreement at COP 21 in Paris, which is a critical step on the path to solving climate change. We pledge our support to ensuring that the level of ambition set by the agreement is met or exceeded.

We will do this by taking concrete steps now, and without waiting for the entry into force of the agreement in 2020, both individually and cooperatively, to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to a safe level and build resilience against those changes already occurring.

We will look back at this moment as our turning point, when the transition to a low-emission and climate resilient economy became inevitable, irreversible and irresistible. We must, we can and, together, we will solve climate change.

Paris, 16 December 2015 – Last week at COP 21 in Paris, governments of the world united in action on climate change by adopting the Paris Agreement the world's first universal climate change agreement. This agreement should spur a transformation of global growth and development and open the door to a stable, sustainable future.

Today, major cities, regions, companies and investors from around the globe promised to quickly and effectively help implement the universal climate change agreement and accelerate the transformative changes needed to meet the climate change challenge.

[L'Appel de Paris](#), or *The Paris Pledge for Action*, brings together a multitude of voices on an unprecedented scale within a single, collective statement:

“We welcome the adoption of a new, universal climate agreement at COP 21 in Paris, which is a critical step on the path to solving climate change. We pledge our support to ensuring that the level of ambition set by the agreement is met or exceeded.”

This landmark pledge is a clear signal that the message sent by the negotiations has been received loud and clear and that all actors are now ready and willing to stand shoulder to shoulder, alongside governments, to implement the terms of the agreement. This is our best opportunity to limit global temperature rise to less than 2 degrees Celsius and raise ambition even before the agreement takes effect in 2020.
