§ 4474a. Registration; fees

(a) The Department shall collect an initial fee of \$50.00 for the application authorized by sections 4473 and 4474 of this title. The fees received by the Department shall be deposited into a registration fee fund and used to offset the costs of processing applications under this subchapter.

(b) A registration card shall expire one year after the date of issue, with the option of renewal, provided the patient submits a new application which is approved by the Department of Public Safety, pursuant to section 4473 or 4474 of this title, and pays the fee required under subsection (a) of this section. If the medical verification form submitted by the patient pursuant to § 4473(b)(2) of this chapter states that the debilitating medical condition is chronic and progressive, the patient who chooses to renew shall not be required to submit a new application, but shall be required to pay a renewal fee of \$25. The Department of Public Safety shall update its medical verification form to include this information.
