**Lt. Governor Phil Scott to work with beekeeper on Wednesday**  
*Part of his "Vermont Everyday Jobs" Initiative*

Lt. Governor Scott will work alongside French Hill Apiary owner Michael Palmer and his staff, as they make up mating nucleus colonies for their queen bees. This process helps to grow the bee stock by splitting the colony into multiple hives.

The work will take place at multiple locations in the St. Albans and Highgate areas. The Lt. Governor will meet up with Mr. Palmer at 10:00 at the commuter parking lot at the intersection of Routes 36 and 104, just off Exit 19 in St. Albans. They will then drive to the hives.
