**Subject:** Moderate Needs Wait List data

Hi,

Below is the table showing the homemaker wait list status as of 12/30/14. The reason I'm not including Adult Day is because they already served 100% of people on their wait list who applied before 1/1/13 and only have a couple of new people.

As a reminder, the goal was to serve 100% of people who applied BEFORE 1/1/13 by December 2014. The table shows the following:

- On 1/1/14, 9 (75%) of home health agencies had a wait list.
- On 1/1/14, 464 people were waiting.
- As of Dec 2014, 6 (50%) of agencies have a wait list.
- As of Dec 2014, 465 people were waiting.
- As of Dec 2014, statewide, agencies served 85% of people who applied before 1/1/14, or 395 people.
- As of Dec 2014, 5 of 9 agencies with a wait list met the goal of serving 100% of people who applied BEFORE 1/1/14.
- As of Dec 2014, 69 out of 465 (15%) of people waiting applied BEFORE 1/1/14.
- As of Dec 2014, 396 out of 465 (85%) of people waiting applied AFTER 1/1/14.

- **NOTE:** The three providers that served the lowest percentage of people who applied before 1/1/14 (VNA CH/GI 79%, VNAV TNH 75%, RAVNAH 75%) also carry 85% of total number of people waiting in the state.
