To the Secretary of the State of Vermont. Sir The  
following is a correct Statement touching the Subject  
of pauperism in the town of Hartford in the County  
Windam for the year ending the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April  
A D 1829-

1 Paupers supported entirely by the Town — Nine  
Of this number one was reduced by intemper-  
ance — two by insanity — One from incapacity  
to support herself — two by sickness — three  
incapable of supporting themselves by reason  
of old age —

2 Paupers partially assisted by Town — Eight  
Of this number four are incapacitated by  
habits of intemperance, — two by being  
cripples and two women incapacitated  
by old age —

The Town has been clear of Law Suit arising  
from pauper cases the past year The whole amount  
of money paid for support of paupers by Town the past year is \$642.
