

TOWN OF LEMINGTON, VT TOWN WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Lemington who are legal voters in the Town Meeting: You are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Lemington Town Hall in said Town, Tuesday, March 6th A.D. 2018 at 7:00 PM to act on the following articles:


- ARTICLE 1: To choose a moderator to govern such meeting.
- ARTICLE 2: To hear the reports of the town officers.
- ARTICLE 3: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$40,000.00 for the maintenance of highways.
- ARTICLE 4: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 for the support of the Colebrook Town Library.
- ARTICLE 5: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 for the support of the Alice Ward Memorial Library.
- ARTICLE 6: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250.00 for the support of the Northern Vermont Chapter of the Red Cross.
- ARTICLE 7: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for the support of the Orleans Essex VNA & Hospice, Inc. for the services of skilled nursing, physical therapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, medical social work, licensed nurse aides, homemaker, personal care attendant, hospice, and maternal child health programs, and other community health programs provided by the Agency.
- ARTICLE 8: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$109.00 for the support of the Northeast Kingdom Human Services, Inc. to assist in maintaining services in mental health, mental retardation, family counseling, services to children and the elderly, substance treatment, and 24-hour emergency services.
- ARTICLE 9: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$450.00 for the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital to help defray the costs of providing emergency services.
- ARTICLE 10: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300.00 to assist the Area Agency on Aging for Northeastern Vermont in providing services to senior citizens in the ensuing year.
- ARTICLE 11: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.00 for the support of Green-Up Vermont.
- ARTICLE 12: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$75.00 for the support of the Vermont Center for Independent Living, a non-profit agency serving persons with disabilities and deaf people in Vermont.
- ARTICLE 13: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$75.00 for the George L. O'Neil American Legion Post 62, to help defray the cost of purchasing flags and markers for the Veteran's graves in our cemeteries.
- ARTICLE 14: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$125.00 for the support of the North Country Community Recreation Center.
- ARTICLE 15: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250.00 for the support of the Essex County Natural Resources Conservation District.
- ARTICLE 16: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250.00 for the Colebrook Kiwanis Fourth of July fireworks.

- ARTICLE 17: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the Essex County Sheriff's Department to help maintain providing proactive patrols in Lemington for the upcoming year.
- ARTICLE 18: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 for the Northwoods Stewardship Center to help provide reduced-cost conservation and educational programs for youth and adults.
- ARTICLE 19: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for the support of the Northeastern Vermont Development Association for planning, development promoting, and publicizing the resources of Caledonia, Essex and Orleans counties with other towns in the three counties.
- ARTICLE 20: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the support of the Rural Community Transportation, Inc. (RCT). RCT is a nonprofit corporation providing transportation to the elderly and disabled, Medicaid and general public through wheelchair accessible van/bus service transporting people to adult-day service facilities, senior meal sites and necessary medical treatments.
- ARTICLE 21: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the support of the Rural Fire Protection Program (RFP). The RFP program helps Vermont communities protect lives, property and natural resources by enhancing fire suppression resources through the use of dry hydrants and other rural water supply systems.
- ARTICLE 22: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 for the support of the Colebrook Fire Department.
- ARTICLE 23: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 for maintenance of the town's cemeteries.
- ARTICLE 24: To determine if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 to provide for future emergency services such as fire or other disasters.
- ARTICLE 25: To choose a Delinquent Tax Collector for a one-year term.
- ARTICLE 26: To determine if the town will vote to raise \$54,734.00 for the Town General Fund.
- ARTICLE 27: To choose all necessary town officers.
- ARTICLE 28: To conduct any other business that may legally come before this meeting.


