November 15, 2002

1. Meeting was called to order at 9:05.
2. Moved to table the election of officers until the December meeting because two board members were absent. So voted.
3. Moved to approve the minutes of the October 18, 2002 meeting with corrections. So voted.
4. Reports
 - a. Moved to ask Jessica Porter, Director to attend the December meeting because she did not attend this meeting as requested. So voted.
5. Complaints
 - a. Pre-denial hearing for Curtis A. Hennigar, Qualifying Agent for C.A.H. Services Airport Parking, Inc. Christopher Winters granted Mr. Hennigar a continuance because his attorney had a conflict.
 - b. Pre-denial hearing for James J. Bartlett as an Unarmed Private Investigator and Unarmed Security Guard for Security One. James Bartlett was not present or represented by counsel. Christopher Winters presided for the Board. Board moved to reverse the pre-denial decision and grant Mr. Bartlett a registration as an Unarmed Private Investigator and Security Guard for Security One. So voted.
6. Licensing
 - a. Moved to approve Scott McDuff's application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with Censor Security. So voted. Danny Coane voted no.
 - b. Moved to approve Control Security Services, Inc. application for licensure as a Security Services Agency with William Vaughan as the qualifying Agent. So voted.
 - c. Moved to approve Allied Security, Inc. - Boston application for licensure as a Security Services Agency with George Guilfooy as the Qualifying Agent. So voted.
7. Other
 - a. Board discussed rules revisions regarding the training program. Chris Winters will draft some thoughts and send them to the Board members for comments. Board requested that staff schedule a meeting for February to meet with Agencies to get their input into what the training program should consist of.
 - b. Board discussed the single employer exemption and made a decision not to change the law at this time.
