I am writing on behalf of the newly formed Lamoille FiberNet Communications Unified District (LFCUD), which covers the towns of Belvidere, Cambridge, Eden, Hyde Park, Johnson, Morristown, and Waterville.

As the LFCUD mobilizes with a sense of urgency, we strongly support Governor Scott's \$2 million appropriation to support the CUD operational expenses. This funding will support CUDs so they will have the local operational capacity they need to make significant on the ground contributions to their communities' broadband expansion.

Without the funding our capacity to serve our local communities will be severely constrained.
