March 1830

Report.

\$750. On the 1st day of October

Annual Return of the State of the Poor in the Town of Newport
for the year ending March 1830 —

There were 12 paupers supported by said town during the year.

We support our poor by having them kept, clothed & provided for in private families at such a rate per annum, the value of their services, where they are able to labor, being deducted.

The expensed supporting our poor during said year was \$228.20 —

The causes which have reduced these 12 persons to pauperism, as far as can be ascertained, are as follows, viz: —

Complete idleness 1; Mental derangement 1; Squandering of intellect 2;
Disease induced by Intemperance 1, Ill health 3; Infirmary and
old age 3.
