This memo is in response to questions received regarding Woodside and youth placed through the Department of Corrections (DOC). These responses are being provided through DCF and DOC collaboration.

1. Please provide the current Memorandum of Understanding between the Department for Children and Families (DCF) and the Department of Corrections (DOC).

This is attached – signed on June 22, 2018.

2. Please provide the number of youth under supervision of the Department of Corrections being served at Woodside.

Over the past nine years, Woodside has served approximately 55 youth under DOC supervision. There are currently two youth being served at Woodside under DOC supervision of the three youth at Woodside now.

3. Provide the number of youth being served in adult correctional facilities.

There are currently zero youth in adult correctional facilities. Youth have been served in adult facilities periodically for short periods of time. DOC's data system does not have a search function specific to this population.

4. Please provide list of residential facilities with security level.

Please see attached. There is one fully locked program – perimeter and units. There are three programs that are Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities with locked perimeters. All other programs are considered “staff secure” and this may include delayed locking systems.
