**WHEREAS,** many citizens of Vermont enjoy the pleasure of riding motorcycles throughout the spring and summer seasons; and

**WHEREAS,** between 2005 and 2009, motorcycle helmet use increased from 48% to 67%; and

**WHEREAS,** motorcycle helmets saved 1,829 motorcyclists' lives in 2008; and

**WHEREAS,** as gas prices continue to rise, people continue to turn to motorcycles for commuting, business, and recreation; and

**WHEREAS,** motorcycles can be difficult for other drivers to see due to their smaller sizes, and car-motorcycle accidents generally have serious results for the motorcyclist; and

**WHEREAS,** simple awareness reminders can help prevent motorcycle accidents; and

**WHEREAS,** the State of Vermont is committed to keeping our roads safe for all citizens;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Peter Shumlin, Governor, do hereby proclaim May 2011 as

**MOTORCYCLE AWARENESS MONTH**

in Vermont and encourage all citizens to be mindful of motorcyclists throughout their summer travels.
