Last fall I visited the home of Melodie and Scott McLane. You probably are aware their home is within close walking distance of the wind towers. The noise emitted from the turbines is very loud. Melanie and I have spoken many times about the disturbance the noise causes in their home life and the lack of comfort it robs from the neighbors. I have visited Georgia Mountain on windy days and on calm days and have observed that even on calm days the turbines can be very loud.

I understand the distress Scott, Melanie and their neighbors experience because of the noise from the turbines. Please do something to give them some relief. I suggest to start you could order full-time monitoring. Also lower noise limits should be implemented immediately at night to allow these people to sleep.
