As a former long-term resident of Newbury, Vermont, who still has family living in the area, I am pleased to provide this letter of support for your application for the Vermont Human Services and Educational Facilities Grants Program's Building and General Services (BGS) grant to renovate your Newbury clinic site.

I have been long acquainted with the services Little Rivers provides in the rural area of east central Vermont and commend you on your willingness to grow to meet the increasing needs of the greater Newbury community. I am aware that as a federally qualified health center, your mission goes well beyond traditional medical primary care to also include community outreach to our schools and local farms, as well as providing public health services like COVID-19 testing and vaccination clinics these past two years.
