To the General Assembly of the State of Vermont: the  
undersigned Selectmen of the Town of Dorset. reports.

That the number of paupers in town is - four  
(to wit:) one idiot, one lunatic, one maimed & one aged.

That we paid for the support of the above four last year \$190.

That we paid for support of another <sup>and</sup> (now dead) within the year 125

That we have paid in a suit now pending about 50  
Total \$365.-

That this town is now as clear of law-suits respecting  
paupers as they have been for a number of years  
past, and that it rarely happens, that fewer  
paupers are on the town for support, than now.
