1. Meeting was called to order at 9:05.
2. Moved to approve the minute of May 17, 2002 with corrections. So voted.
3. There were not public comments.
4. Licensing
  - a. Moved to table Daniel J. Spear's application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with Armored Motor Services of America (AMSA). So voted.
  - b. Moved to deny Larkin A. Forney's application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with Lemieux Security based on Title 26, Chapter 59 § 3181 (b)15) and Title 26, Chapter 59 § 3181 (b)18). So voted.
  - c. Moved to approve James Bizon's application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with Deter Security. So voted.
  - d. Moved to approve Eric Saltonstall's application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with Deter Security. So voted.
  - e. Moved to table Henry Davis's application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with Murphy Detective/ADA. So voted. Mr. Davis stated he wished to discuss his VCIC record in open meeting rather than going into Executive Session.
  - f. Lennert Holbrook appeared before the Board to discuss his application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with FJC Security Services. Rebekah Holbrook also appeared before the Board. Board moved to approve his application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with FJC Security Services. So voted. Mr. Holbrook stated he wished to discuss his VCIC record in open meeting rather than going into Executive Session.
  - g. Moved to deny Jamie Jarvis's application for licensure as an Unarmed Security Guard with Lemieux Security based on Title 26, Chapter 59 § 3181 (b)15) and Title 26, Chapter 59 § 3181 (b)18). So voted.
  - h. Moved to table Seth Wheeler's application for qualifying agent and application for licensure of the Poma Wheeler Agency as a private investigative agency until Mr. Wheeler has taken and passed his examination.

- i. Moved to deny Michael E. Diener's application for licensure as an Armed Security Guard with Hunter North Associates based on Title 26, Chapter 59 § 3181 (b)15) and Title 26, Chapter 59 § 3181 (b)18). So voted.
- j. Moved to approve Stephen F. Delorme's application for qualifying agent and approve Stephen F. Delorme as a private investigative agency. So voted.

5. Other

- a. Board discussed Brink's monthly report dated May 22, 2002. The Board discussed options for verifying the information in the report. Moved to table the discussion until the July meeting.
- b. Board discussed H.761 and the ramifications of the fee increase and the training program. Chair Coane and Nancy Morin, Administrator will draft a memo to be sent out to the Agencies regarding the fee increases.
- c. Board discussed the E-mail from Randy Watson regarding requirements for licensure as a private investigator. After a discussion the Board requested staff send the Board's laws and rules and a letter stating the Mr. Watson needed to review the laws and rules and decide whether he needed to be licensed or not.
