# Vermont's Not for Profit Hospitals: Facts and Figures

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Major Vermont employers

- 15,000 direct jobs\*
- 27,000 indirect jobs

Physician office visits: 3.5 million


Outpatient visits: 3.3 million

Inpatient visits: 45,000

"Payer Mix" 41% covered by Medicare, 16% covered by Medicaid, 43% by commercial insurance

Budgeted revenue increase: FY2014 2.7%    FY2015 3.1%
