In other words, please provide those 30 pages you also withheld from Vermont Watchdog. I can't imagine that the entirety of those documents (subject line, recipient's and sender's names, etc.) are exempt.

If you believe an otherwise public record is exempt from disclosure, produce a log with the page numbers of the documents, the date of the document, the people or entities who received copies, the authors of the document and a specific explanation (citing to the applicable exemption) for why a document has not been produced;

If an otherwise public record has a portion that is exempt from disclosure, redact any exempt portion and release the redacted document together with a log (as described in the previous bullet);

Hi Paul, attached please find records in response to your public records act request dated July 7, 2015. We have redacted personal contact information pursuant to 1 VSA 317(c)(7) and commercially sensitive information pursuant to 1 VSA 317(c)(9). The same records withheld from the WatchDog production were withheld in response to this request as executive privileged communications pursuant to 1 VSA 317(c)(1) and (c)(4) – specifically, the withheld records are substantive communications regarding a draft press release amounting to approximately 30 pages.

If you feel any information has been withheld in error, you may appeal to the Governor's Chief of Staff, Darren Springer, pursuant to 1 VSA 318.

I understand you are making additional public record act requests of this office, including requests for EB-5 related communications and SEC related communications. Now that we have completed this request, we will start to process your additional requests and will be in touch.
