E	<25	QUALIFYING CRIMES INCLUDING BURGLARY (NOT INTO O/DWELLING)	5 YRS IF RESTORATIVE PROGRAMMING OR PUBLIC SERVICE COMPLETED	

In all instances restitution must be paid in full and the court must find that the ends of justice are served by the expungement or sealing.
