**Act 153:
An act relating to inmate access to prescription drugs**

Submitted to: House Committee on Corrections and Institutions; Senate Committee on Institutions

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Introduction

Act 153, “An act relating to inmate access to prescription drugs,” states that individuals who are admitted to a correctional facility while under the medical care of a licensed medical provider and taking medication pursuant to a valid prescription shall be entitled to continue that medication unless determined by a licensed medical provider that it is not medically necessary. Section 2 of the Act requires that the Department of Corrections (DOC) collect information on, “how often a medication for which an inmate had a valid prescription is continued or discontinued upon incarceration at each correctional facility, the name of the medication, and the reason for discontinuance.” In addition, the DOC was charged to “collect this information for a period of at least six months and provide a written report of its findings based on the data collected, including a breakdown by correctional facility of record, to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate Committee on or before January 31, 2019.” The Act also requires the DOC to consult with the Prisoners’ Rights Office and Disability Rights Vermont. This report will present and analyze the data collected related to medication verification and continuation upon admission to a Vermont correctional facility.

Method

Vermont DOC currently uses an electronic health records (EHR) system, Correctek, to record the comprehensive correctional healthcare provided by Centurion of Vermont, the contracted health services provider, for individuals in a Vermont correctional facility. Correctek has a reporting module that allows Centurion staff members to obtain data from the EHR. Prior to the passing of H. 874, Centurion was collecting information about medications verifications upon admission. After Act 153 was enacted, DOC coordinated with Centurion to modify the EHR reporting to include additional data fields, allowing Centurion to collect the information necessary for the new reporting requirements. In consultation with the Prisoners’ Rights Office and Disability Rights Vermont, DOC determined to collect a “Med Verification – Disposition” which would indicate whether the medication was:

- Continued from the community as ordered
- Modified due to approved clinical guidelines
- Modified due to safety and security concerns
- Discontinued due to approved clinical guidelines
- Discontinued due to safety and security concerns
- Community order not current/verifiable
- Patient refusal

The addition of a “modified” category was determined appropriate (as discussed with Prisoners’ Rights and Disability Rights Vermont) based on the data collected for the first several months. It was found that medications are modified in certain cases and it was determined that modification of a medication to a therapeutic equivalent or similar did not fit into the two categories, continued or discontinued, provided in the Act. Therefore, the data presented shows the number of continued medications divided by the number of verified medications,

the number of modified medications divided by the number of verified medications, and the number of discontinued medications divided by the number of verified medications. In addition, for all cases of modified or discontinued medications, they have been categorized by the reason for the change, either “Not meeting approved clinical guidelines¹,” or “Safety and security concerns².”

The medication names, as required by the Act, are also presented in raw data form by category, continued, modified, or discontinued. Duplicates have not been removed in order to indicate the frequency of the medications.

Considerations

With regard to data reporting from any electronic system, it is important to note that the data received from the reporting module is only as good as the information that is entered into the system. This data was obtained via inserting a workflow process for medical staff to document each medication verification and outcome. If a “Medication Verification – Disposition” was not entered into the correct field or the info entered was not correct, manual research of the case by Centurion regional office staff was required.

The data presented below excludes cases in which a medication was self-reported but not found to be an active prescription in the community. For reference, the following summarizes the numbers of medications that were reported to medical staff but were not found to be valid or active prescriptions in the community.

¹ For purposes of this report, these are medications which are commonly prescribed off-label for the treatment of certain conditions yet for which the FDA or other entity has indicated that there are no or limited clinical justifications for its use.

² For purposes of this report, these are medications which are changed in some manner, such as in terms of their formulation, while working to continue the same class of medication. In some cases, the medication may be changed from an extended-release capsule to a tablet to allow it to be crushed to facilitate the absorption of the pill while decreasing the risk of abuse or diversion. For example, Wellbutrin XL is the extended release version of the medication which is commonly prescribed in the community, yet in DOC, the medication is modified to Wellbutrin which is crushed to prevent diversion, and which may need to be administered more than one time per day.

Data Analysis

The DOC continued 64.3 percent of all medications as order in the community and modified 22.7 percent of medications to a therapeutic equivalent or similar. **Overall, approximately 87 percent of medications were continued as ordered or modified.** The predominant reason for modification was to adhere to approved clinical guidelines. On average, 12.9 percent of medications were discontinued by the medical provider upon admission. The rates of continuation, modification, and discontinuation were fairly consistent from month to month but varied by facility.

In reviewing the list of medications that were continued, modified, and discontinued, it was determined that many medications appeared on multiple lists or in some cases all three. This indicates that decisions are being made on a case by case basis to determine medical necessity in lieu of strict bans of specific medications in correctional facilities. The top five most discontinued medications were: Adderall³, Vyvanse⁴, Methylphenidate⁵, Gabapentin⁶, Ritalin⁷.

Further breakdown of the data by facility:

CRCF

At Chittenden Regional Correctional Facility, medications were continued as ordered in the community 68.0 percent of the time over the six-month period. Medications were modified 17.8 percent of the time and discontinued 14.2 percent of the time. This is consistent with the data for all sites.

MVRCF

At Marble Valley Regional Correctional Facility, medications were continued as ordered in the community 67.3 percent of the time over the six-month period. Medications were modified 19.6 percent of the time and discontinued 13.1 percent of the time. This is consistent with the data for all sites.

NECC

³ Generally prescribed for ADHD in the community. In DOC, stimulants for the treatment of ADHD are generally only prescribed in cases where the patient is unable to sustain attention on particular tasks (school, programming, etc.) and a medication is needed to help them focus.

⁶ Generally prescribed for chronic pain in the community. The only FDA indications for the usage of gabapentin are postherpetic neuralgia in adults (pain related to shingles) and the partial onset of seizures, with and without secondary generalization, in adults and pediatric patients 3 years and older with epilepsy (https://www.accessdata.fda.gov/drugsatfda_docs/label/2017/020235s064_020882s047_021129s046lbl.pdf)

At Northeast Correctional Complex, medications were continued as ordered in the community 55.4 percent of the time over the six-month period. Medications were modified 29.6 percent of the time and discontinued 14.9 percent of the time. Data was consistent with the all sites data during July through September then the rates of medication modification increased October through December impacting the overall continuation rates for the six-month period.

NSCF

At Northern State Correctional Facility, medications were continued as ordered in the community 70.6 percent of the time over the six-month period. Medications were modified 14.7 percent of the time and discontinued 14.7 percent of the time. It is important to note that the data for NSCF contained very few medication verifications and therefore conclusions cannot be drawn from this site's data alone. The reason for the low numbers of medication verifications at the NSCF is that very few "Initial Healthcare Receiving Screenings" (i.e. intakes) occurred at NSCF during the reporting period because NSCF is primarily for sentenced individuals that have already gone through the medication verification process at another correctional facility.

NWSCF

At Northwest State Correctional Family, medications were continued as ordered in the community 70.3 percent of the time over the six-month period. Medications were modified 19.0 percent of the time and discontinued 10.7 percent of the time. Rates of continuation at this site were slightly higher than the all sites data.

SSCF

At Southern State Correctional Family, medications were continued as ordered in the community 57.8 percent of the time over the six-month period. Medications were modified 30.1 percent of the time and discontinued 12.1 percent of the time. Rates of continuation at this site were slightly lower and rates of medication were slightly higher than the all sites data.

Conclusion

The majority of medications (87%) were continued as ordered by the community-based provider or modified. Four of the five most commonly discontinued medications are stimulants, generally for the treatment of ADD/ADHD, with high rates of abuse and diversion in correctional settings.

Decisions about medication continuation are considered on a case-by-case basis, and there is consistency across facilities regarding the continuation, modification, or discontinuation of

medications to conform with the prevailing medical standards for correctional healthcare programs.

Always with an eye towards continuous quality improvement, it is noted that medication verification is a time-consuming and largely manual process which could be made more efficient. Efficiency could be improved by developing an electronic interface to a robust prescribing network which has the capacity to provide real-time information on prescription status directly in the DOC's EHR. This type of interface would permit healthcare professionals to make more timely decisions about medications rather than waiting for information to be manually transmitted from pharmacies or the patient's community-based healthcare provider.

Act 153: Medication Continuation Report

(a) The Department of Corrections shall collect information on: how often a medication for which an inmate has a valid prescription is continued or discontinued upon incarceration at each correctional facility, the name of the medication, and the reason for discontinuance. (b) The Department shall collect this information for a period of at least six months and provide a written report of its findings based on the data collected, including a breakdown by correctional facility of record, to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Institutions on or before January 31, 2019. Prior to finalizing the report, the Department shall consult with the Prisoners' Rights Office and Disability Rights Vermont.
