Lt. Governor Phil Scott to work at Stowe Mountain Resort on Sunday

On Sunday morning, Lt. Governor Scott will welcome skiers and snowboarders to Stowe Mountain Resort, checking tickets and loading lifts. He will experience first-hand some of what it takes to make one of Vermont's most popular tourist and recreation destinations run efficiently.

The Lt. Governor will meet up with Stowe officials at 8:30 AM at the Mountain Operations Center.

This visit had originally been scheduled for Monday, March 7, but was postponed due to the snowstorm and due to Lt. Governor Scott's responsibilities that day as acting Governor.

Lt. Governor Phil Scott started his "Vermont Everyday Jobs" initiative to promote Vermont businesses and highlight the hard work that Vermonters do every day in all areas of our economy.
