I would expect that the Judiciary will develop another standard form, like the standard affidavits that exist for people seeking relief from abuse orders and other family court orders. A link to existing family court forms, including affidavits, is below. Standard forms are sometimes attached to judicial rules. Your question makes the good point that the language on judicial rule making that is already in the bill should likely be expanded from The Supreme Court may promulgate rules under 12 V.S.A. 7 § for judicial proceedings under this subsection to something making clear that the court may promulgate rules to implement the entire *section*(?). I defer to the Senator and Erik on that. Thanks Bill.
