7 Sec. B.1. NO FUNDING OF CURRENT COLLECTIVE BARGAINING
8 AGREEMENTS; CONSIDERATION OF ANY RENEGOTIATED
9 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

10 (a) The General Assembly will not fund the collective bargaining
11 agreements between the State and the Vermont State Employees' Association
12 for the Defender General, Non-Management, Supervisory, and Corrections
13 bargaining units; for the State's Attorneys' offices bargaining unit; and for the
14 Judicial bargaining unit, and between the State and the Vermont Troopers'
15 Association, for the periods of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022, as currently
16 presented.

17 (b) The General Assembly is willing to consider renegotiated collective
18 bargaining agreements that provide more moderate compensation increases
19 and reflect the State's ongoing revenue constraints.
