What's missing is the Senate Judiciary place holder for the money. There has been broad agreement from both the Judiciary Committee and the Administration on this. Unless and Until the Appropriations Committee acts to the contrary the Senate Judiciary plan is as follows;

Revenue generated by the act shall be allotted in the following formula:

1. 25 percent to prevention of substance abuse;
2. 25 percent to treatment of substance abuse;
3. 25 percent to law enforcement and criminal justice agencies for efforts to combat the
illegal drug trade and drugged driving;
4. 25 percent to the General Fund for the implementation, administration, and enforcement
of this act with any remaining funds allocated equally among the first three priorities.

If Ira could work from this it would be helpful. The only agency that had requests in in time to be included in the bill was the Department of Public Safety and I worked on the allocation of \$60 K for legislative council since they need to staff the commission.

Please feel free to talk to Michele and I for clarification.
