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REASONS FOR EMR

Enhance Resident Safety and Quality Outcomes

- Data collection and trend analysis
- Error reduction
- Standardized process
- Alerts/Flags for missing information
- Removes redundancy in documentation .



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Revenue Generation

- EMR increases the accuracy in documenting the care provided
 - which can result in high Medicare and Medicaid revenue
- Other Veterans Homes has experienced an increase in revenue of 5% to 25% after installation of EMR use
- Increase accuracy in insurance building
 - Reduces need for double entry of information.



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Boost Profitability

- Documentation supports reimbursement
- Cost analysis


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Clinical Reporting and Quality Assurance (QA)
