My name is Michael Sweetser I am a 46-year-old master electrician who runs my own electrical business MCS electric I struggled with alcohol and drug addiction from the age 15 to age 43 during that time I was incarcerated numerous times I went to numerous detoxes and treatment centers and I also bought and traded Suboxone to help me with my recovery process.in my opinion Suboxone and methadone are a good way to full and complete abstinence but are not a long-term lifetime solution I believe people being incarcerated for Suboxone use is foolish and a waste of our taxpaying dollars I support Tom Dalton and his assessment on the law review in regards to Suboxone not being a criminal offense to possess or to use under DOC supervision This is only my opinion and my views based on my personal experiences with The process of attempting to recover fully from a life of addiction. My Sobriety date is September 7, 2015 and I am a member of Alcoholics Anonymous I have a sponsor I work the steps I go to meetings and I don't pick up a drink or drug one day at a time. Since getting sober I have not committed a crime I've started my own electrical business which is very successful and I currently am the caregiver to my two grandchildren which are one years old and three years old. Suboxone was part of my path and I support Tom and his assessment with the Suboxone law review.
