Timeline for COL Process

Date	Activity
13-Mar	State of Emergency declared
15-Mar	Directive closing schools: meals, providing childcare for essential workers, maintenance of education and plan for extended dismissal beyond 4/6
17-Mar	Directive closing childcare, except for care of children of essential workers
24-Mar	Stay home, stay safe directive
26-Mar	AOE Guidance to prepare for transition to COL Schools are required to have continuity of learning plans for remote learning implemented on or before Monday, April 13, 2020 AOE Guidance to prepare for transition to COL
1-Apr	Guidance released (3 documents), after feedback from VSA, VPA. Misinterpretation about timeline/NEA, unable to incorporate feedback in time. https://education.vermont.gov/documents/cover-page-continuity-of-learning-plan-tool
8-Apr	Initial deadline for CLPs, to receive feedback from AOE in time for 4/13 implementation.
13-Apr	Implementation of CLPs
22-Apr	Final CLP plans due to AOE
