Below is VHCB's anticipated disbursement and schedule information on FY2019 and FY2020 bonds as of December 31, 2021. We are providing this to satisfy the 32 V.S.A. §701a(d) requirement for a report to the Institution Committees on the current fund balances of authorized projects with unexpended funds from sessions two or more years prior to the current session. They have all been obligated and are awaiting disbursement as projects proceed.

For FY2019 Bonds:

Commitments: \$5,640,273
Disbursements: \$5,485,750.26
Balance to Disburse: \$154,522.74

For FY2020 Bonds:

Commitments: \$4,543,170
Disbursements: \$3,509,378.58
Balance to Disburse: \$1,033,791.42

Please let us know if you have any questions or need additional information. We look forward to appearing before your committees in the coming weeks to present results from the state's capital investments through VHCB in recent years and the FY22-23 Capital Bill Adjustment.
