1. The meeting was called to order at 1:35 p.m.

 - e. Jane Alsofrom and Carla White attended the Board meeting to discuss the Board of Radiologic Technology Proposed Administrative Rules. Specifically, the inspections of chiropractic x-rays and whether mandated x-ray continuing education should be required for licensed chiropractors with x-ray privileges. Ms. White submits a report to the Board of Chiropractic once she has completed an inspection. The Board will review every report that is submitted and if there is an issue with any inspection, the Board will also contact the licensee notifying them that they must follow up with Ms. White of any infractions she may have found. If there are concerns regarding retakes, the Board may go to the Chiropractors office to view more x-rays. The Board will talk with the Vermont Chiropractic Association about possibly offering an x-ray course for continuing education for any licensee to take if they wish. Ms. Alsofrom stated that because chiropractors are not doing floral and do plain films

and that having the Chiropractic Board looking at reviews makes her feel more secure. She stated that the Chiropractic Board is assuring public safety by reviewing the reports done by Ms. White. She will take this information back to the Board of Radiologic Technology.

f. Elections:

Mr. Coane nominated Dr. Peet for Chair of the Board, seconded by Dr. Rice. Dr. Peet was elected Chair of the Board.

It was determined to wait until the Board's next meeting to elect Vice-Chair of the Board.

g. The Board's next meeting is scheduled for February 3, 2015 to begin at 1:30 p.m.
