- a. **Malvnowski, Michael** (Civil)-The Board at their November 6, 2008 meeting reviewed the additional information submitted by Mr. Malvnowski. Upon further review, the letter dated October 2, 2008 was in error. Mr. Malvnowski did graduate from a four-year approved curriculum in engineering technology. However, the licensing standards in Massachusetts, New Hampshire and Maine are not substantially equivalent to Vermont's so Mr. Malvnowski is not eligible for licensure by endorsement. The Board determined that Mr. Malvnowski does not have 16 years of active engineering practice. He only has 12 years.
