Hi David –

As I mentioned last week, VAAFM is drafting protocols for the hemp program. Based on our conversation and conversations VAAAFM had with the hemp team in other states, it sounds like the following is an appropriate protocol for law enforcement referrals:

**Law Enforcement –**

In the event a sample is found to contain greater than 0.3% Total THC (combined  $\Delta$  9 THC and THCA) dry weight:

- results will be immediately reported to local law enforcement (*County Sherriff, State's Attorneys*) and to the Vermont Department of Public Safety/Attorney General,
- Any remaining hemp material from the initial analytical sample and the split sample will be (*retained, turned over to law enforcement*), depending upon Law Enforcement requirements,
