Confidential: Litigation Strategy

This case directly involves the Department which has disputed Colchester's exemption for an elder daycare center leased by Fletcher Allen to another non-profit (really). The judge denied summary judgment for both parties, but made a number of findings in favor of Colchester. I had already told staff that I thought this case should be settled (frankly should have settled before I arrived here) – I only agreed to wait because by the time I got involved this decision was expected any day. Now that the day has come, I will push staff on settlement – but in meantime, thought you should know. Quite likely you will hear about it.
