

DRAFT- S.54 Conference Estimates
Proposal Discussed on Aug.24

Proposal:

- 14% state excise tax
 - 200 basis points of the 14% tax would be dedicated to localities.
- After 200 basis points are carved out of 14% excise tax, the remaining revenue would be split in two funds:
 - 30% would be allocated to a Substance Misuse and Prevention Fund
 - 70% would be allocated to the General Fund.
- State licensing fees are to be determined by the Cannabis Control Board some time in FY21 or FY22.
