WHEREAS, the State of Vermont acknowledges its appreciation to the craftspeople who have enriched the lives of people throughout the United States and abroad; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper to embrace and celebrate the creativity of all Vermonters;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Peter Shumlin, Governor, do hereby proclaim October 2013 as

AMERICAN CRAFT MONTH

in Vermont.
