According to DMV, approximately 22,000 Vermonters hold a Class A or Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL), but only 1200 of these drivers (less than 6%) have a Hazardous Materials Endorsement.

Hiring Drivers

Federal Requirement & State Requirements

- Pass CDL road and written test
- Pass Federal background check and hazmat endorsement test
- Pass drug pre-application test
- Pass a DOT Medical Exam
- Pass LP Gas Certified Employee Training Program (CETP) Book 1 (Basic Principles and Practices of Propane); Book 2.1 (Propane Delivery Operations), Book 2.2 (Bobtail Delivery Operations), and 2.4 (Cylinder Delivery) *Propane Drivers Only*
- *Must be 21 for inter-state transportation*
- *Can be 18 for intra-state transportation*



Typical Requirements of Insurance Carriers

- Minimum driving age between 23-25.
- Drivers under 25 must possess clean MVR and have between 2 and 5 years prior CDL tractor driving experience
- No more than 3 moving violations during the last 3 years.
- No license suspensions for any reason in previous 3-5 years.
- No alcohol or drug related motor vehicle violations in past 5 years
- No more than 2 moving violations in the past 12 months.
- No more than 2 at-fault accidents in past 3 years
- No major motor vehicle violations in previous 3 years, such as excessive speeding (greater than 20mph over posted), Careless & Negligent, Avoidance, too fast for condition, leaving the scene, passing a school bus)
