Dear Ms. Zimmerman:

Under the provisions of 44 C.F.R. §206.36(a), I hereby request an extension until May 23, 2014 to submit a request for a major disaster for the State of Vermont as a result of flooding and flash flooding on April 15-18, 2014.

Pursuant to 44 C.F.R. §206.36(a), I am submitting this written request for an extension within 30 days of the occurrence of the incident. The reason for this delay is because joint preliminary damage assessment required site visits which extended into a second week, and additional time is required to complete the verification and analysis of Preliminary Damages Estimates.

PDAs are expected to be completed by May 14. FEMA should expect to receive the request by May 23.

I have designated Ross Nagy as the State Coordinating Officer for this request. He will work with the Federal Emergency Management Agency in damage assessments and may provide further information or justification on my behalf.
