Vermont Impaired Driver Rehabilitation Program (Formally known as CRASH)

SERVICE	FEE	PAYMENT MECHANISM	SERVICE DESCRIPTION
Registration/Assessment	\$180	Registration and Assessment is a bundled fee that must be paid prior to beginning the Educational Program. Payment is made by money order or bank check. Payment made directly to community CRASH program.	Client interview with Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor (LADC) to gather history and to administer standardized tests to determine level of treatment needs
Weekday Educational Program	\$220	Fee is paid to the Educational Program prior to attending.	Total of ten hours of classes that occur once a week over a 4 week period
Weekend Educational Program at the Howard Center (Overnight)	\$600	Fee is paid to the Educational Program prior to attending. Money order only.	Classes held over the weekend, beginning on Friday and ending on Sunday. This program includes the cost for overnight accommodations
Weekend Educational Program in White River Junction (Day program)	\$500	Fee is paid to the Educational Program prior to attending. Money order or PayPal	Classes held over the weekend, beginning on Friday and ending on Sunday. Does not include overnight accommodations
Counseling	Fee-For-Service/covered by Medicaid or insurance, or client can pay cash	The participant bears the responsibility for the cost of treatment and any related payment arrangements. May be covered by insurance (incl. Medicaid) if meets medical necessity.	Substance abuse counseling including individual, group or residential level of care.

Note: Vermont's fees and required number of class hours are less than NY, NH and Maine.
