Karen, Michel,
You will recall we only used 5 MHz for uplink and 5 MHz for downlink when we demoed the LTE performance for you a few weeks ago?
I wanted to show you that we since increased this to 10MHz up and 10 MHz down and the resulting speeds are excellent as you can see in the attached slide from a speedtest October 25 in Springfield. (60 Mb/s!) This is of course just showing what the system is capable of when lightly loaded, once you have a lot of subscribers they will of course have to share the bandwidth but the experience will still be great. For example, here in Dallas I routinely get 15 Mb/s or better downlink and 10 Mb/s uplink on the commercial AT&T network which is now quite loaded with subscribers.

Karen,

Thanks and that's a helpful summary of a lot of new information. Intrado didn't say they were exclusive. They said they knew their rates were near impossible for rural sites and prohibitive for 4GLTE. We need to look to alternatives. The message I take from this is that we need to make clear to FCC and PSB we are data only. That might mean using Google or Skype for voice even if we spent heavily on our own voice service. I almost want to say the Public Safety folks are dangerous in that it isn't their money, there are no limits in dealing with multi billion dollar "clients" and it is another example of the obsolete switched voice wireless world being top-heavy. I think if rural Vermonters were to be asked "You can call 911 and tell them where you are and otherwise have your identity confidential and call 1000 minutes a month for \$25 a month, or you can call 911 and they know where you are and your identity is not confidential and call 1000 minutes for \$100 a month, many would choose the former.

Here's how I understand the role of Intrado:

Intrado is a turnkey network provider to both the telco industry AND the E 911 Public Safety Answering Points.

Vermont's E911 system has a contracted relationship with Intrado as their backend provider of all call handling and network elements. Vermont E 911 pays Intrado for these services that supply a hosted network to all public safety answering points (9) in the state. They are the network operator, offering a suite of functionality to E911 systems from call handling to workstations to screen management software.

From your information, they are ALSO the provider to the telco industry; within wireless they look to provide the location service for a handset and the emerging text2 911 capacity. Phase I and II refer the accuracy level of proximity for location services.

As I understand your concerns, their "rate card" for services is a monthly per installation fee, regardless of population served. Interesting model.

Does Intrado represent that they may be the exclusive provider to wireless companies in VT by virtue of the host system?

What provider does VTEL utilize for E 911 call handling for its land line business?

Some information about Vermont's E 911 system:

- currently, Intrado is the system host
- Vermont's system is one of only a few statewide e 911 systems
- The system is IP based today, far ahead of most and has completed trials on text 2 911 capabilities; these have proved to be life saving in at least 2 cases in the field
- 60% of calls are from wireless devices, 15% overall also originate from out of state wireless phones
- the basis for all revenues that support Vermont's e 911 system is the state USF, levied on voice services

Maybe there is an opportunity we don't see.

The giant wireless operators pay the fees on a per site basis, but the fees seem crippling in rural villages where there are few customers.

Very strange talk with Richard Winne, salesman for our region for Intrado.

He didn't want to talk without a confidentiality agreement in place, and said would take some days, and so consequently my information was sort of dragged out of him and may not be correct.

He indicates Intrado serves AT&T and Verizon, as well as over 100 rural carriers.

He indicates price for E-911 to be built into 4G/LTE can't possibly be afforded in rural Americas small sites, and it's simply out of the question. He says it is barely understood how to price this even in cities, it, but it will be easily way over the Phase 2 prices, which are already many times the Phase One prices, and Phase One is \$ [REDACTED] to \$ [REDACTED]/month.

He says Coverageco in Vermont was able to persuade Vermont's 911 folks to list them as Phase 1, which costs them about \$ [REDACTED] month for each of 1,000 femto-cells, because the cells are so weak they cannot cross-connect to keep track of location, but someone like us using more powerful Ericsson 3G technology would almost certainly be required to use Phase 2, at about \$ [REDACTED]/month per site, but all of this pales compared to the crippling costs of VOLTE over 4G/LTE.

Quite a shock!

We keep adding an extra wireless site here and there, in a process that will presumably (we hope) continue forever. Speed tests of our 4G/LTE to laptops are at about 60 Mbps which is quite wonderful and suggesting that 100 Meg is within reach in a year or two. Adding "receiver boosters" makes process of reaching Smart Grid AMI's much easier, though only real-life implementation will be finally determinative. Subject to Will Dodge clarifying a one-page MOU add-on to our complex 20 SBA contracts, we are close to 100 signed contracts, of 189 targets, with another 75 under active negotiation to contract, and only 14 in the category of "How do we solve this one?". Ericsson is coming in this week to order radios for these sites. I feel like I'm always exaggerating by 5% or so, and on a bad day 8%, so please discount these numbers a small amount. Nonetheless, each week is more progress. Obne of my daughter Diane's first tasks will be to work closely with Curt to begin Smart Grid cutovers, when she arrives Dec. 4.

I promised you a list of 50 sites by the 1st, but have been delaying several days as we try to conclude a relatively large contract. As a temporary 'hold' the attached October 1 list shows 55 sites under contract. The additional 20 sites we hope to have in several days could move this to 75. Several details could derail this extra 20, and will let you know soon. I will translate the enclosed spreadsheet into more readable format as soon as I know from Will Dodge whether this new 20-site contract is ephemeral, but the raw data for a first 55 sites is here.

Overall we have 167 of 186 sites defined and under negotiations.

FCC Auction 901 award of \$2 million yesterday helps build more.

We are selling a large and important non-Vermont wireless asset to create a further \$24 million of pre-tax revenue, to build cash for project needs.

All is going OK, but every day is another battle.

Karen, thanks for your email.

To be honest, I have a little bit of anger and regret to hear that Rob Callahan from Woodstock contacted you about the need for connectivity at the Pomfret School. I specifically gave Rob an opportunity to write a letter of support for VTel to add the build to the Pomfret school to our BTOP grant and he declined to do so. As you know, our final grant revision was sent to the NTIA some time ago. It is moving forward and we believe much of it will be approved in the next month or so (fingers are crossed).

I do not recommend that VTel build fiber to the Pomfret school, because, frankly, I do not have any faith that even if we did so, we would obtain a contract from Woodstock. I am considering reaching out to ENA to contact Woodstock with a solution and for VTel to supply fiber to ENA, rather than directly to the schools. This is because I do not expect the current decision makers (i.e., Rob) to select VTel directly for whatever reason....

I apologize if this email comes across as negative. There is a longer story here that we can discuss live whenever you have a moment.

Tess, would you be so kind as to forward your recent email exchange with the high school IT person regarding connectivity? I will do the same regarding Pomfret...

I'm jumping in at this point after touching base with my team this morning.

It is my understanding that we have a form of license that is agreeable to all. It needs to be filled out based on the information contained in the license applications. I'll confirm that we have received this week the revised applications, and now the ball is in our court to complete the license template on each of the three sites based on that information. We are working on that today (now), and we will finish as soon as we can. There will be some additional drafting work to do beyond filling in blanks driven by the need to make final occupancy contingent of approval of structural analysis, selection of final height, etc. that was not submitted as part of the revised application. (I believe this is understood by Will and is the resolution of the "chicken and egg" discussion he mentions below.) Again, we are working on that right now.
