I just learned from DEC that they are requesting that the "JARD" property in Bennington be considered for Superfund status. They have spoken to Stu Hurd and he, according to Trish Coppelino, was sorry to see this have to happen, but understands that this is a very contaminated property. PCB contamination is very high and widespread. The term, "Superfund", is scary to some folks, but does allow for more \$\$ to be put toward clean-up. I am guessing that this isn't widely known at this point.

I know that Plasan was looking at using this site (or one adjacent to it) as more parking.

I will talk to Peter O. at some point about this – this isn't going to be terribly positive for the community. Prior to speaking with him, I will get the facts from DEC.
