2 Representative Webb of Shelburne moves that the House concur in the  
3 Senate proposal of amendment with further proposals of amendment as  
4 follows:

5 First: In Sec. 3, school facilities inventory and conditions assessment;  
6 Agency of Education; Department of Buildings and General Services; report,  
7 in subsection (a), by striking out “coordination” and inserting in lieu thereof  
8 “consultation”

9 Second: In Sec. 10, State Energy Management Program; financing for  
10 schools, by striking out “coordination” and inserting in lieu thereof  
11 “consultation”

12 Third: In Sec. 12, radon testing; school facilities; Department of Health, in  
13 the title, by striking out “; Department of Health”; by striking out subsection  
14 (a) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

15 (a) On or before June 30, 2023, each public school and approved  
16 independent school, as defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11, shall perform a radon  
17 measurement in accordance with the ANSI/AARST protocol for conducting  
18 Radon and Radon Decay Products in Schools and Large Buildings (MALB-  
19 2014) on any facility that has not had a test completed in five or more years;  
20 provided, however, that any public school or approved independent school that

1     is engaged in implementing an indoor air quality improvement project prior to  
2     June 30, 2023 shall perform a radon measurement on or before June 30, 2024.  
3     and in subsection (b), by inserting “and approved independent school” after  
4     “public school”
