Subject: CT decision on our renewable credits

Hi Senator MacDonald,
I wanted to let you know that Connecticut issued a draft decision on the renewable energy credit issue we have discussed.

From the link below you can see on page 11 the conclusion Connecticut reached is that the RPS legislative effort underway in Vermont would make our program compatible with the region. They are therefore holding off on deciding if there is a double counting claim in 2017 related to SPEED, at least in part because of the RPS legislation (H.40 and S.51) pending.
