<p><b>McGrath House</b> 699 Mass. Ave. Boston, MA</p>	<p>McGrath House is a <b>30-bed</b> facility serving female offenders referred by the <b>Suffolk County Sheriff's Department, the Federal Bureau of Prisons and the Massachusetts Parole Board</b>. All McGrath House women receive comprehensive case management services, with the goal of successful reentry to their home communities. The services at McGrath House are provided in a gender-responsive environment, geared to meet the unique and complicated needs of the women involved with the program. <p><b>Brooke House</b> 107 Park Drive Boston, MA</p>	<p>With a capacity of <b>65 beds</b>, the Brooke House serves as a pre-release program for male offenders through contracts with the <b>Suffolk County Sheriff's Department, the MA Department of Corrections, and the Norfolk County Sheriff's Department</b> and as transitional housing for offenders through a contract with the <b>Massachusetts Parole Board</b>. The average length of stay at Brooke House is approximately 3.5 months. <p><b>Hampshire House</b> 1490-1492 Elm St. Manchester, NH</p>	<p>With a capacity of <b>32 beds</b>, Hampshire House serves as a Comprehensive Sanctions Center for male and female offenders under contract with <b>Federal Bureau of Prisons</b>. Residents are referred from the Federal Bureau of Prisons, US Probation and Federal District Courts. Most residents are in the program for an average of 3 months, during which time they receive case management services that emphasize successful reentry. Hampshire House works with a diverse population with regard to age, type of Federal offense, and length of incarceration. 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<p><b><u>Horizon House</u></b> 35-37 Elizabeth St. Albany, NY</p>	<p>The newest program in the SIS Department, and the first in New York State, is the Horizon House in Albany, NY, open in September 2011. With a capacity of <b>32 beds</b>, Horizon serves as a Residential Reentry Center for male and female offenders under contract with the <b>Federal Bureau of Prisons</b>. Residents may be referred from the Bureau of Prisons, U. S. Probation, and Federal Courts. Most residents are in the program for an average of 3 months, during which time they receive case management services that emphasize successful reentry. <p><b><u>Coolidge House</u></b> 307 Huntington Ave. Boston, MA</p>	<p>With a capacity of <b>120 beds</b>, Coolidge House serves as a Residential Reentry Center for male and female offenders under contract with the <b>Federal Bureau of Prisons</b>. Residents are referred from the Federal Bureau of Prisons, U.S. Probation and Federal District Courts. Most residents are in the program for an average of 3 months, during which time they receive case management services that emphasize successful reentry. Coolidge House works with a diverse population with regard to age, type of Federal offense, and length of incarceration.
