Good Afternoon Denise,

Last week, during Secretary Cohen's testimony, the Committee on Government Operations requested some additional information regarding the Community High School of Vermont and Information Technology within AHS and DII. Below and attached is that information.

Questions from the Committee:

What does DII Charge AHS CO? What is the number of IT staff? What is the Budget numbers for IT?

-DII charges that the AHS CO will pay via Internal Service Fund charges: \$330,458

-Number of IT staff in the AHS CO (Includes both Limited Service and Permanent): 11 LTS + 49 Perm = 60 Total

-Budgeted Salary and Fringe for AHS CO IT staff (assumes no vacancies): \$6,063,063 (all funding sources) or \$1.8M in GF (combination of GF and match required for GC)

2. What does DII provide to AHS

AHS IT and DII ultimately have similar information technology goals but serve mostly different, yet complimentary, roles.

AHS IT's Mission Statement:

To guide the Agency's Central Office and its six departments (DAIL, DCF, DOC, DMH, DVHA, and VDH) in the planning, procurement and development of secure, interoperable solutions thereby enabling AHS to successfully accomplish its mission: to "improve the conditions and well-being of Vermonters and protect those who cannot protect themselves".

until late 2014 when Secretary Chen requested AHS IT assist directly with the VHC project as part of the Incident Command Structure. Since 12/31/2014 AHS IT has officially taken on the responsibility for the Software Maintenance and Operations contract previously held by DVHA/DII.
